



NODWEDDION BYWYD GWYLLT HEN GOEDEN WILDLIFE FEATURES OF A VETERAN TREE



There are a significant number of veteran trees within Blackweir Woods, which is a Site of Interest for Nature Conservation (SINC). Veteran trees are defined as those with habitat features similar to those found on ancient trees.

They provide valuable, complex habitats and are home to a large number and wide variety of species. One characteristic is they contain dead wood, which has a risk of sudden collapse.

Elsewhere in the park, this wood (or if necessary the whole tree) would be removed on safety grounds.
